

Anti-TNF alpha [cA2 (Infliximab)] Standard Size Ab00146-23.0

This chimeric rabbit antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original Human IgG1 format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Immunogen: Purified recombinant human TNF (rTNF).

Specificity: Binds to soluble and transmembrane forms of TNF-alpha and neutralizes its biological activity. Does not bind to TNF-beta.

Application Notes: This antibody can be used to detect and neutralize human TNF alpha. Unlike Adalimumab (Ab00718), Infliximab does not bind to mouse TNF alpha (Arnoult 2017, PMID: 28584008).
