

Anti-DNA/RNA G-quadruplex [BG4] Standard Size Ab00174-24.1

This chimeric goat antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original Mouse scFv format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Immunogen: DNA/RNA G-quadruplex.

Specificity: Binds with high selectivity and low nanomolar affinity to DNA and RNA G-quadruplex structures.

Application Notes: This antibody has been shown (by ELISA) to bind selectively to G-quadruplex forming DNA and RNA structures. Please that Fab-based versions as well as scFvs, with and without Flag-tag are available, which needs to be considered when replicating published methods. Tsai et al. (2022 et al. PMID: 36440760), report similar activity between whole-antibody and scFv-based versions of BG4. Weldon et al. (2016, PMID: 27820800) used Ab00174-1.1 to identify G-quadruplexes in long functional RNAs using an electrophoretic mobility shift assay (EMSA). The mouse IgG1 version of BG4 was shown to have weak cross-reactivity with iMotif structures (2018, PMID: 29686376). iMotif structures can be detected selectively using our anti-iMotif antibody Ab01462.

Note on publication: Describes generation of a G-quadruplex-specific antibody using phage display and the in vitro selection (using ELISA and CD) of a structure-specific antibody probe that binds with high selectivity and low nanomolar affinity to DNA G-quadruplex structures called BG4.
