

Anti-CD28 [JJ316] Standard Size Ab00284-6.1

This chimeric rat antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original Mouse IgG1 format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Immunogen: Made by immunizing BALB/c mice with rat CD28 cDNA-transfected A20/J cells.

Specificity: Recognises rat CD28 and can trigger T-cell proliferation in vitro and in vivo.

Application Notes: This antibody binds rat CD28 and can convey as a co-stimulatory signal. At 100-1000-fold higher concentration than required for co-stimulation JJ316 (unlike the clone JJ319 marketed by competitors (see Tacke et al. 1997)) can induce proliferation of all T-cell subsets without TCR engagement.
