

Anti-Alpha-Synuclein [NAC32] Standard Size Ab00346-1.1

This chimeric mouse antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original human yeast surface display scFv format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Immunogen: Biotin-labeled peptide spanning amino acids 53-87 of alpha-synuclein.

Specificity: Binds the nonamyloid component of alpha-Synuclein.

Application Notes: This is a synthetic IgG binding to alpha-Synuclein which is involved in the regulation of dopamine release and transport. It induces fibrillisation of the tau-protein and reduces the neuronal responsiveness to several apoptotic signals. Involved in the pathogenesis of Parkinson disease.
