This reformatted human antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original Human IgA format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Specificity: The antibody binds to the N-terminal region of TG2 with a Kd of 55 nM.

Application Notes: This antibody binds to human Transglutaminase 2, an enzyme that catalyzes the isopeptide bond formation between an amine group and an acyl group at the end of the side chain of a glutamine. Anti-TG2 antibody are found in celiac disease and high levels of transglutaminase are found in Huntington's and Parkinson's.
