

## Anti-Bos d 5 [D1] Standard Size Ab00650-10.6

This is a Fab fragment with a his-tag.

This reformatted human antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original Human scFv format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Published Application(s): crystallization

**Published Species Reactivity:** Cow (Bos taurus) **Immunogen:** Bos d 5, a major allergen found in milk.

**Specificity:** This antibody binds to bovine beta-lactoglobulin, a member of the lipocalin protein family. It binds to an epitope in the beta-sheet strucutre that is not part of the most antigenic area of Bos d 5 accessible for IgG antibodies, but it may have overlapping areas with minor antigenic sites.

**Application Notes:** This antibody binds to Bos d 5. A Fab version of this antibody has been used in a cocrystallization study.
