

Anti-Rhesus IgG1 [3C10.3] Standard Size Ab01623-23.0

This chimeric rabbit antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original Mouse IgG2c format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Immunogen: This antibody was raised by immunizing mice against a rhesus immunoglobulin.

Specificity: This antibody is specific to rhesus IgG1.

Application Notes: This antibody is recommended for the detection and analysis of rhesus IgG1. It was shown to react specifically with rhesus IgG1 via ELISA. The specificity of this antibody was further confirmed when it was used in research on CD4 follicular helper T cell skewing on antibody responses to an HIV-1 vaccine in rhesus macaques (Verma et al., 2020; pmid: 31827000).
