

Anti-Ankyrin-G (staining) [N106/43] Standard Size Ab02125-23.0

Variable region sequences were determined by Dr. James Trimmer at the University of California, Davis, as supported by National Institutes of Health BRAIN Initiative award U24 NS109113.

This chimeric rabbit antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original Mouse IgG1 format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Immunogen: This antibody was raised by immunising BALB/c mice with the Ankyrin-G antigen.

Specificity: This antibody is specific for the Ankyrin-G antigen in both humans and rats. This antigen is a membrane-cytoskeleton linker.

Application Notes: This antibody has been used for immunocytochemistry in the analysis of neurons. It was successfully used to label the initial axon segment (Dumitrescu et al, 2016; PMID:27932952).
