

Anti-GFAP R416WT [N206B/9] Standard Size Ab02152-8.1

Variable region sequences were determined by Dr. James Trimmer at the University of California, Davis, as supported by National Institutes of Health BRAIN Initiative award U24 NS109113.

This chimeric rat antibody was made using the variable domain sequences of the original Mouse IgG1 format, for improved compatibility with existing reagents, assays and techniques.

Immunogen: This antibody was raised by immunising BALB/c mice with a synthetic peptide amino acids 411-422 (KTVEMRDGEVIK) of human GFAP.

Specificity: This antibody is specific for GFAP and does not cross-react with GFAP-R416W or other proteins. GFAP, a class-III intermediate filament, is a cell-specific marker that, during the development of the central nervous system, distinguishes astrocytes from other glial cells.

Application Notes: This antibody is recommended for the detection and analysis of GFAP R416WT by western blot, immunocytochemistry and immunohistochemistry. For instance, the mouse version of this antibody was used to detect GFAP R416WT by western blot in brain samples from adult rat and GFAP wildtype, knockout and R416W KI mice. Furthermore it was used to detect GFAP R416WT by immunocytochemistry in GFAP WT and KO mouse hippocampus.
